



The first ESGNTA Online Course title: "PERSONALISED PHAGE THERAPY: BASIC PRINCIPLES OF MONITORING AND TREATMENT"

will take place on the 7-10th of June 2022. It will include four sessions with cutting-edge scientific talks in the field of personalised phage therapy, including (1) therapeutic monitoring, (2) immune response to bacteriophages, (3) formulation and administration of bacteriophages for therapy, and (4) current state and prospects of oral phage therapy.
